KNOW YOUR SAINTS SAINT LEONARD OF PORT MAURICE

Saint Leonard's feast day is November 26. Born Paul Jerome Casanova in Italy, he was the son of a ship captain. He was sent to a Roman college with the priests at 13 years, as he was a very bright young student. He had originally planned on being a doctor but was called to serve God and became a brother choosing the name Leonard. Eventually he was ordained a Franciscan priest and became a missionary. He was supposed to work in China but unfortunately, he became very ill and was sent home. When he recovered, he travelled around Italy preaching missions and often stayed in the town hearing confessions. He promoted the Stations of the Cross and six hundred places put up stations because of him. He traveled and preached tirelessly but knew it was also important to take time to have quiet time to pray. He preached to other people to draw them to Jesus. He died in Rome at 75 years old.
