Despite the race weekend last month, many items of food and \$76.65 were collected for the Centretown Food Centre. A recent report on Housing in Canada identifies Ottawa housing as "severely unaffordable". This explains in part why the demand on the food centre continues to grow. In the most recent report from the Manager of the Centre, 1600 people were provided food during the month of May, of which 387 were children. That is the equivalent of one elementary school. This number grows each month. The need is so great. Your generosity makes a huge difference in the lives of these, our neighbours. Thank you so much.
